IMPORTANT WEEKEND TRAINING DATES

Sunday, February 9th – Joint Seamanship Training Day (Mandatory Training)

- Dress is C4 (work dress). Please ensure you have boots, ballcap, black undershirt, pants, belt, and blue shirt on, if you do not have a uniform, please wear closed toe shoes and pants. If you do not have an issued jacket, please bring an appropriate dark colored jacket. Don't forget your ranks!

- **Pickup will be at the ship, at 1600h (4pm), cadets will call when we are on our way.**
- **This is a mandatory training day.**
